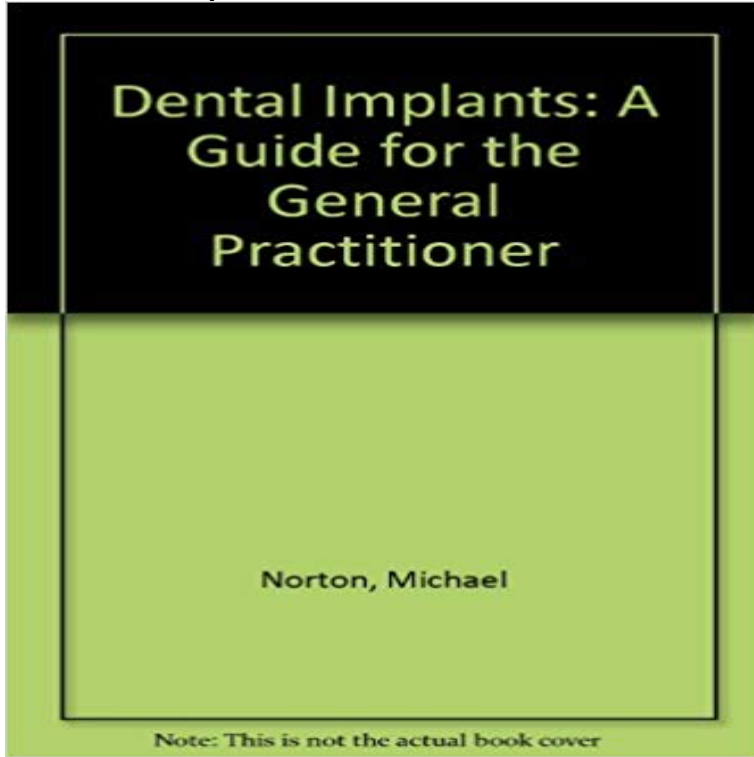


Dental Implants: A Guide for the General Practitioner
