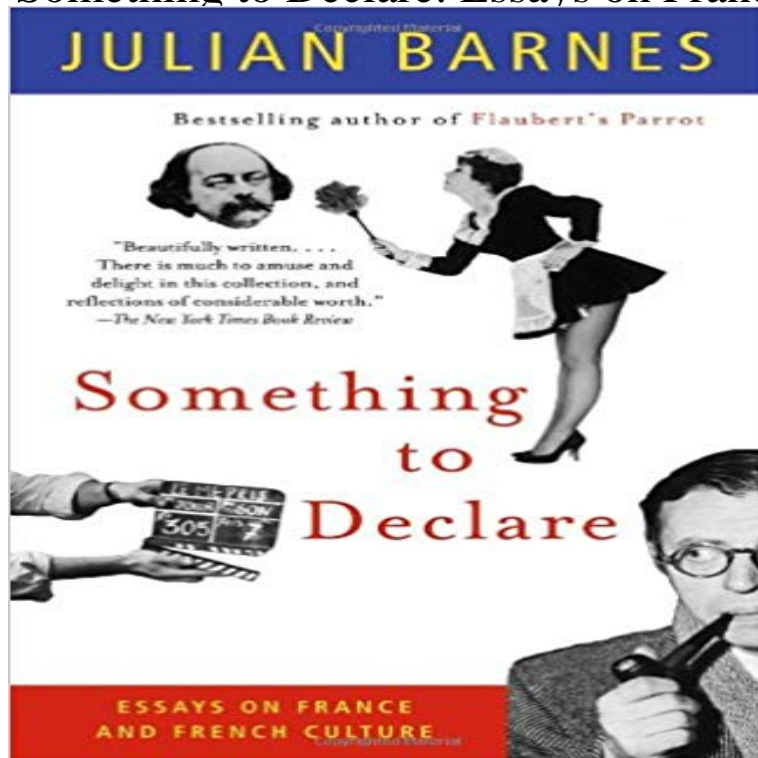


Something to Declare: Essays on France and French Culture
